Any summary documents or tallies showing how many residents or stakeholders expressed support or opposition. Houston Fire Department Involvement: Any internal communications (emails, memos, meeting notes) within the Houston Fire Department referencing the Austin Street bike lane and its alleged interference with training or operations. The name(s), title(s), and station number(s) of any HFD personnel who reported the blockage of the training area or confirmed training suspension. Paving and Removal Costs Documents showing the total cost associated with the repaving and restriping of Austin Street in 2024. Any documentation, work orders, or internal communications showing how or why the repaving was identified as "needed" at this time. Bike Lane and Lane Reconfiguration Planning Records detailing when and how the original bike lane design was approved, and who was involved in that decision. Any internal discussions or external stakeholder communications that proposed or influenced the lane reconfiguration or removal. All relevant contracts, change orders, or notices to proceed related to the redesign and removal of the bike lane. If any portion of this request is denied, please cite the specific exemption(s) under the Act that you believe justify the refusal and inform me of the appeal procedures available.
